Master of Arts in Teaching with Initial Teaching License at the Middle and High School Level

Subject area: ART Admissions Portfolio Requirement

All applicants to the MAT with Initial Teaching License in the Middle/High School level subject area of art are required to submit a portfolio showing examples of their art work.

The following are guidelines for the portfolio requirement.

- Your portfolio should reflect your current interests and demonstrate your drawing/painting/ sculpture/design skills. Include a variety of mediums in order to show as many skills as possible. Variety is preferred. Don't send one medium. You may include examples of a recent series or a course.
- The portfolio should include 12-15 examples of your art work.
- The portfolio must be submitted in digital (CD) or 35 mm slide format. Actual, original art pieces will not be accepted.

Guidelines for documenting your work:

- **35mm camera:** Be sure that you are using the correct film for the lighting you choose. When using slide film, take several shots of the same piece. Original slides cost less than reproductions.
- **Digital camera or scanner:** Use the following specifications for your digital files: 72 dpi, 640x480 pixel dimension and JPEG format at medium/5 setting.
