The Courage to Lead Program for educational administrators is a personal and professional renewal program that meets in a retreat setting. The program offers school leaders the time and space to reflect on the complex, challenging, and changing dimensions of their leadership experiences. The Courage to Lead Program is designed to help leaders move beyond the “what” and “how” questions of leadership to the “who” questions. It is rooted in the belief that effective leadership flows from the identity and integrity of the person.

WHERE: Menucha Retreat and Conference Center, located in the Columbia River Gorge in Corbett, Oregon, twenty-two miles east of Portland

WHEN: Check in at 4:00-6:00 p.m., begin with dinner at 6:00 p.m. Thursdays (or Sunday, July 14, 2013) and end after lunch on Saturdays (or Tuesday, July 16, 2013).

COST: Total for all four retreats \$1,560* (includes retreat, room and board, double occupancy).

Deposit of \$200 due with application.

Due on or before September 27, 2012 = \$580.

Due on or before May 9, 2013 = \$780.
