Session 1: For incoming grades 6 & 7 Monday-Friday, June 23-27, 9 a.m.-12 p.m. Session 2: For incoming grades 8 & 9 Monday-Friday, July 14-18, 9 a.m.-12 p.m.

In these workshops students will turn their notebooks to a new page. They will locate the stories they carry, take risks in writing, learn to turn memory into fiction, fiction into poetry. They will write to a wide variety of prompts while honing skills through craft lessons that build both language dexterity and knowledge of genres.

Instructor Session 1: Anna Wessinger is an Oregon Writing Project coach. She has taught middle school writing for 11 years at West Sylvan and Sellwood schools. She is a poet, essayist, and memoirist.

Instructors Session 2: Charles Sanderson and Kristen McMurty are Oregon Writing Project coaches and both currently teach middle school—Charles at St. Helens MS and Kristen at Five Oaks Middle School in Beaverton. Both have guided their students from rough-draft writing to performance in poetry slams.
