Data Notes

Our initial programs (Elementary & Secondary Education) are 13-month cohort-based programs and in 2021-22 a part-time cohort running 25-months was added to the Elementary Program. Our most recent full-time cohort graduates matriculated in 2021-22 and were recommended in summer 2022. Candidates are allowed up to 5 years to complete.

Trends

After expected time to degree, licensure rate in our Elementary program has been consistently high over time.

Data Notes

Our initial programs (Elementary & Secondary Education) are 13-month cohort-based programs. Our most recent program completers matriculated in 2021-22 and were recommended for licensure in summer 2022. Candidates are allowed up to 5 years to complete.

In Oregon, program completion is statutorily defined as recommendation for licensure. EPP-recommended candidates have met all requirements for licensure, but not all program completers are ultimately licensed. (e.g. candidates who get jobs out-of-state may not need to file their Oregon licensure paperwork).

Trends

After expected time to degree, licensure rate in our Secondary program has been consistently high over time.
