

**Master of Arts in Teaching with Initial 1 Teaching License
Middle-Level/High School Program
2011-12**

The Lewis & Clark M.A.T. program with Oregon Initial 1 Teaching license for middle level and secondary school teaching consists of a minimum of 40 semester hours (SH) of graduate study. Designed in consultation with a faculty advisor and according to student background and interest, individual programs include 2 SH of coursework from the innovative Graduate Core Program and elective courses in the subject area. Programs leading to licensure are available in the following areas: Art, English Language Arts, Mathematics, Music, Science (choose Biology, Chemistry, Integrated Science, or Physics), and Social Studies.

Minimum Required for M.A.T: 40 Semester Hours

All courses applicable to the master's degree, which include four (4) semester hours of subject area elective and two (2) semester hours of CORE must be completed within five years from date of admission to the program.

Minimum Requirements for Licensure (ITL1):30 Semester Hours

Students who have successfully completed the following: all licensure course requirements(*), one subject area elective, the internship, and have passed the required tests (listed below) can be recommended for the Oregon Initial 1 Teaching License.

Testing Requirements for Licensure:

Praxis I or CBEST or WEST-B: Mathematics, Reading and Writing

NES/ORELA or Praxis II: Subject Area Tests (Praxis II if taken before 09/2010)

ORELA tests: Multiple Subjects Examination (MSE) Subtests I and II (optional for Art and Music)
Protecting Student and Civil Rights in the Educational Environment Test
