Master's in Education with Principal License Course & Sequence Sheet 38 Semester Hours

The Master's in Education with Principal License program is a semi-structured cohort in that students begin the course sequence in the fall semester. As practicing professionals, students advance through the on-campus program at their own pace, but the recommended sequence allows for possible completion in seven (7) terms. Program length depends on the number of courses taken per semester and the students' own time line for finishing the requirements. A minimum of 8 semester hours will be earned as electives chosen jointly by the advisor and student from courses in the Educational Leadership Departments (EDAD & EDLL) or Teacher Education Department (ED).

Regional, off campus classes are cohort-based. Metro students are not offered regional classes for this reason. The program currently has active cohorts in Central Oregon and Eastern Oregon (Pendleton and Ontario).
