| 10:00 a.m. | Ceremony <ul style="list-style-type: none">Once degree candidates have been hooded, exited the platform, and have had their photo taken in front of the Lewis & Clark backdrop, program faculty are welcome to stand and offer congratulations.Graduates unable to shake hands or hug have been instructed to greet platform party members and faculty holding their diplomas with both hands. |

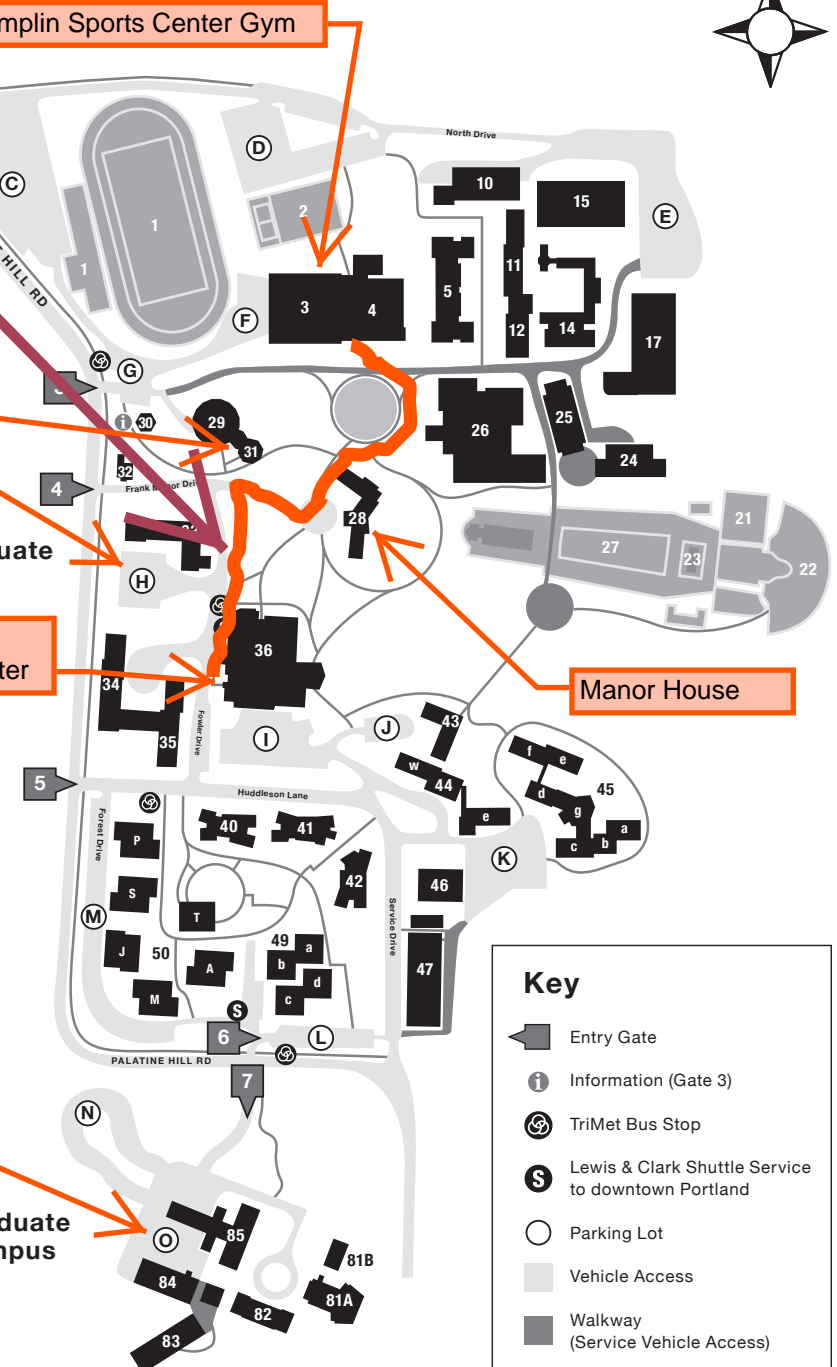

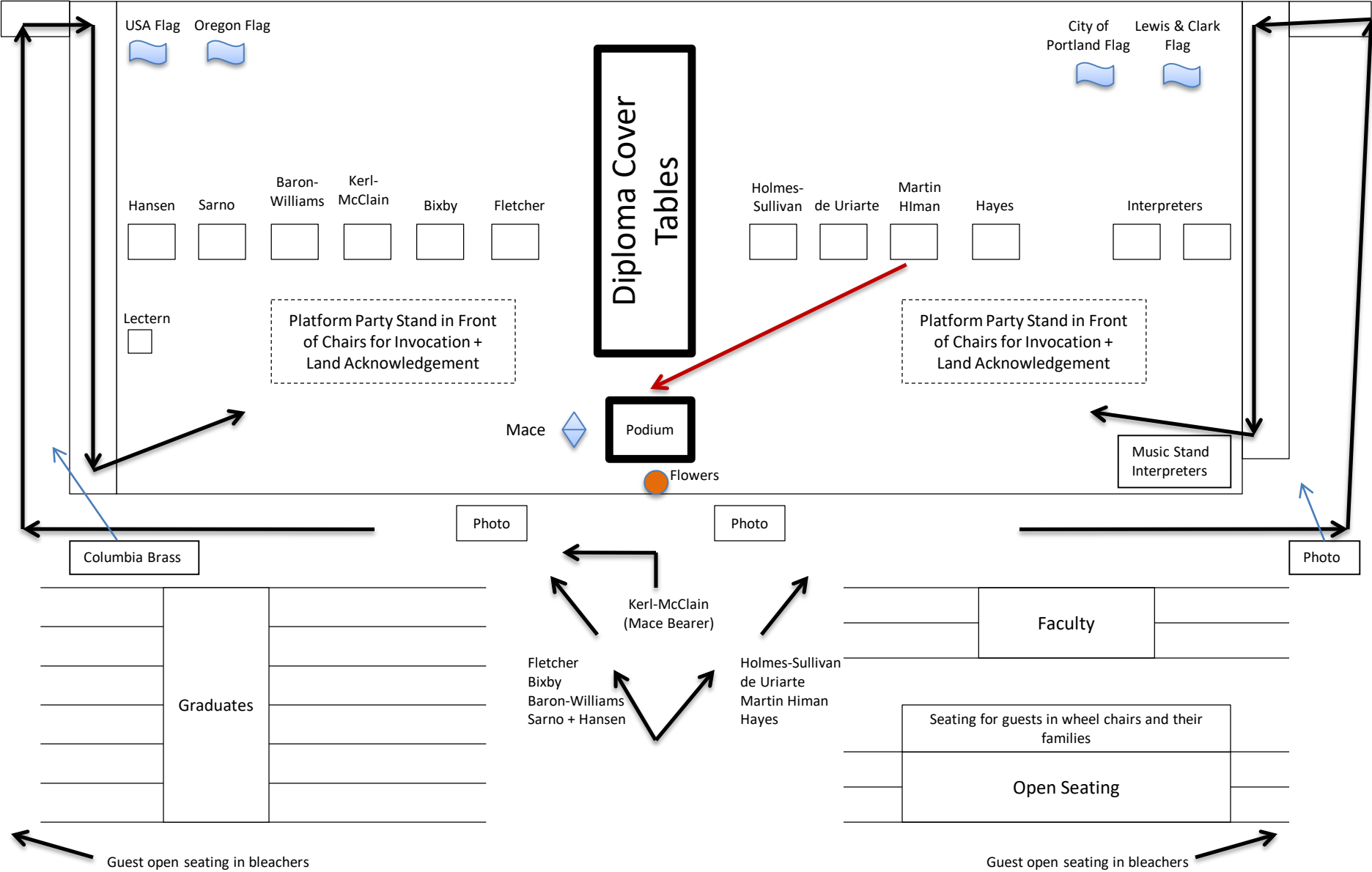

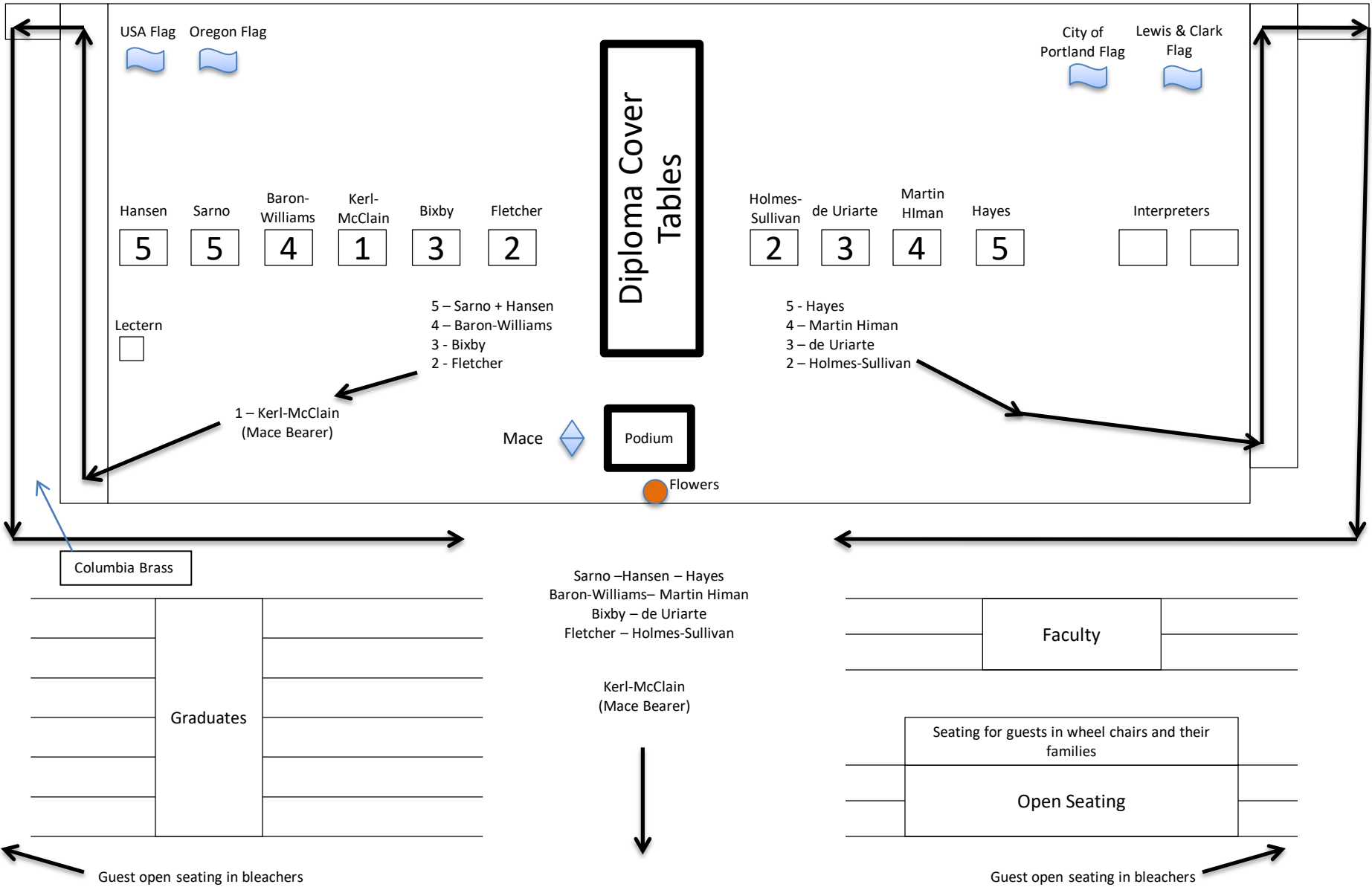
