- Ensure graduates are holding their hoods across the correct arm
 - *"Left arm, velvet back, point in, unbuttoned.* Candidates will line up by degree and, within degrees, by program.

Seating – All Student Marshals

- Student marshals will lead students to seating through the center aisle. All students sit on the left, filling from front to back.
- There are 17 rows of 14 chairs. Once the student marshal reach the first empty row, stop and count **14 students** per row. Once the row fills, the marshal will move to the end of the next empty row and repeat. ***They will need to scrunch in. There should be no empty seats.***
- Once students are seated go the reserved seats for faculty marshals on **the left side in the front row, near the outside aisle**. Remain standing.

Rows will be dismissed front to back

- President Robin Holmes-Sullivan will confer degrees
 - *Dean Fletcher: President Holmes-Sullivan, it gives me great pleasure to present the 2023 candidates for degrees from Lewis & Clark Graduate School of Education and Counseling. Will the candidates please rise? **THIS IS YOUR CUE TO APPROACH YOUR STATION.***
 - *President Holmes-Sullivan: By the virtue of the authority vested in me by the Board of Trustees of Lewis & Clark College, under the law of the state of Oregon, I confer upon these graduates the master's, educational specialist and doctoral degrees with all the responsibilities and privileges thereto appertaining.*
 - **Dean Fletcher, will say: *Will the graduates please come forward at the direction of the marshals.***
- Student Marshal Stations

- **Linda** will be stationed at the bottom of the ramp where students enter the stage to ensure they have their name cards. Blank cards and sharpies will be on hand.
- **Mary** will stand at the outside aisle at the first row to 'dismiss' students to approach the stage.
- **Chelsey** will be stationed at the bottom of the exit ramp to guide students to the photographer, then back to their seat through the center aisle.
- **Heather** will be stationed at the front of the center aisle to motion students back to their seats via the center aisle
- **Peter** will be stationed in the center aisle near the first chair of the empty row to which students will return.
- After the last of the graduates has crossed the stage and returned to their seats, all student marshals will position themselves near the graduates in the center aisle, spread out among the rows to prevent students from recessing until after the stage party and faculty have recessed.
- Rows can then be dismissed, back to front

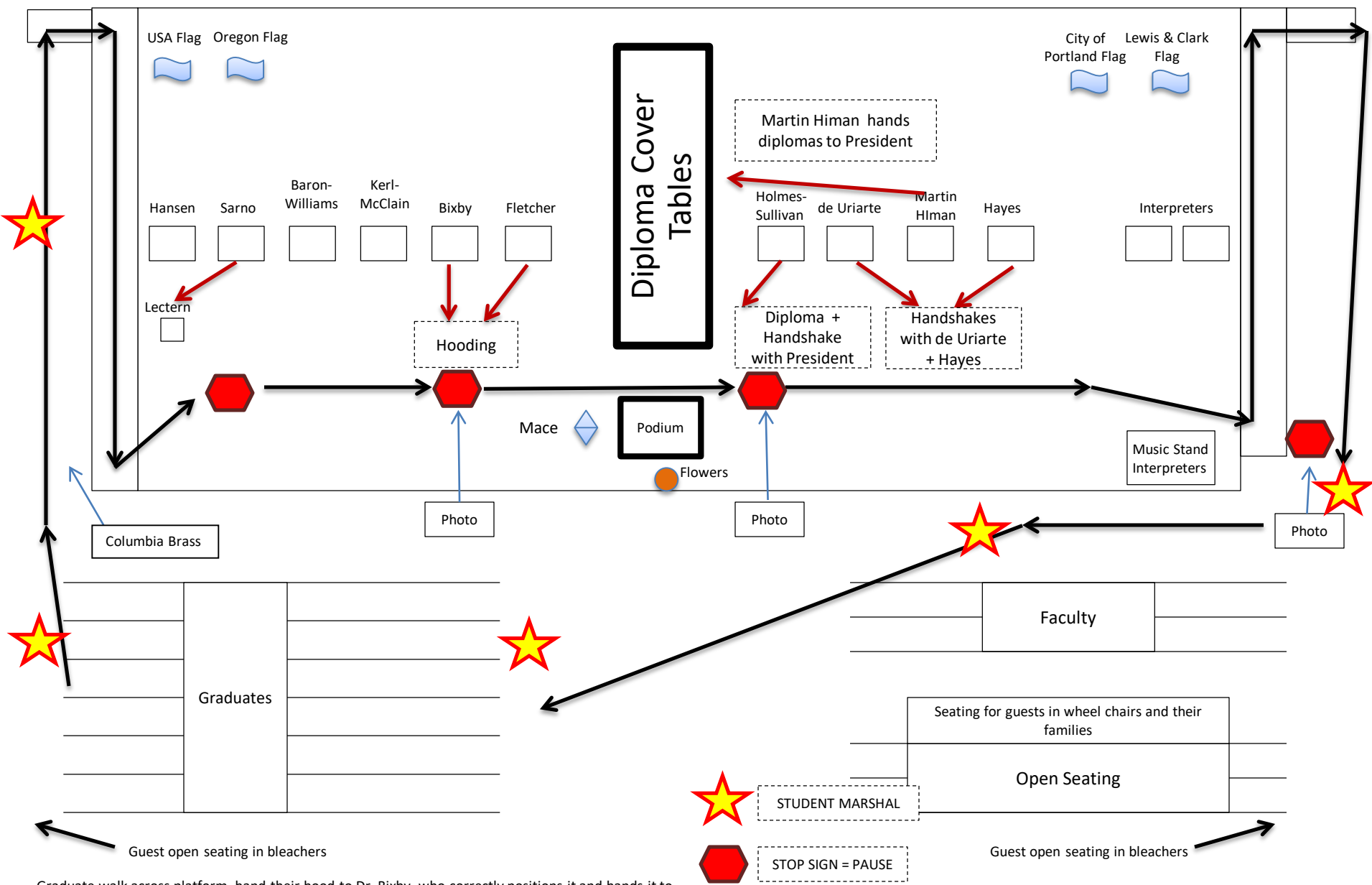
